

USER MANUAL

Thank you for choosing the ARB Jump starter! Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances. Read all instructions carefully, Please keep this instruction manual for easy reference.

B. OPERATION GUIDANCE

Press the switch to check the storage level of ARB Jump starter

The indicator will flash one by one during the period of charging. Different number of solid indicators show different storage level of ARB Jump starter. All indicators light off when the charging is paused or completed.

ARB Jump starter Charging Instruction:

- 1. Plug the home adaptor into the universal socket.
- 2. Connect 15V 1A input port of ARB Jump starter to the other end of home adaptor.
- *Note max charging time should not exceed 24hrs.
- 1. Plug the car adaptor into the socket of cigarette lighter. 2. Connect 15V 1A input port of ARB Jump starter to the other end
- of car adaptor.



Jump start 12V vehicle Instruction:

- Connect the blue plug into the jump start socket making sure the plug is fully seated into the socket. Make sure cable indicators are off.
- Connect Red Clamp to the positive (+) battery terminal, Black Clamp to the negative (-) battery
- 3. Operate following the instruction of the Cable

4.Start the vehicle.

- 5. When the vehicle is started, remove the jumper cable from the vehicle battery. Leave the vehicle's engine running.
- *Note: Please make sure to remove the clamps within 30s after the vehicle has started.

Charging Cell Phone or Tablet Instruction:

- 1. Plug the USB cable to USB 5V 2A output port.
- 2. Select appropriate connector and connect it to your mobile phones or tablet.
- 3. Press the switch button to charge.





For power supply to 12V vehicle products or 12V electronics

- 1.When 12V electronics/automotive products connected to the cigarette lighter port.
- 2. Press the switch button to power supply. *Note: Power draw from 12V 10A output can not exceed 10A, do not use items exceeding 10amps.

Press the switch 3 seconds to start the LED flash light. There are 4 modes of LED light appear in order (normal, strobe. SOS. off) if you press slightly.

1. Always make sure the blue plug of the jumper cable is connected and seated tightly into the socket of the ARB jump covered under the standard warranty. Please always check the blue plug cable is seated tight and correct.

2. Always check the jumper clamps are well connected to the

- battery terminals, if battery terminals are rusted or dirty please clean first to make a good connection. Do not exceed three jump starts in the same session, it will damage the unit. The vehicle may have other problems for not starting.
- 3. DO NOT connect the two clamps. Otherwise, it may be
- 4. DO NOT disassemble the host. There is no serviceable items inside this unit.
- Always take care when using the appliance
- This appliance is not intended for use by young or infirm persons without supervision
